Complete the State approved Application for New/Renewal of a Firearms Identification Card (FID) or License to Carry Firearms (LTC) in its entirety. Be sure to check both the front and backsides of the application to ensure completion.

Applicants are urged to carefully consider Question 4, found on Page 2 of the application.

The question refers to <u>any</u> criminal charges brought forth against you. If you appeared in court as a defendant, you must answer the question "YES" and provide as much detail as possible. <u>Failure to answer this question accurately and completely is grounds for denial of the application.</u>

<u>LICENSING FEE:</u> Applicants must submit a State regulated, non-refundable administrative fee with the completed application.

FID (Class C)	\$100.00	Free for renewals 70 years old and older
FID (Class C) under age 18	\$25.00	No Fee Exemption
